BELIEF

'Citius, Altius, Fortius' is the motto for the Olympic Games that started in Paris on Friday. The three Latin words mean; *'Faster, Higher, Stronger'* which are words taken from Father Henri Martin Dideon, the Headmaster of Arcueil College in Paris in 1894 and words that were originally used at the start of the Olympic movement at the end of the 19th Century and which has once again, been adopted for this year's Games. The Olympic Games motto is all about *perseverance, ability, performance and results* and to *excel and succeed* at the highest level. It's also about *stamina, commitment, determination* and having a *'confidence in your ability'* too, believing you can actually achieve the impossible and often the improbable. It's tough to win a Bronze, Silver and especially a Gold medal which comes down to one word, *'Belief'*, but when you have *'belief in yourself'*, anything is possible. This summer, I want to encourage you all to have more belief in yourself. More belief in your ability. More belief in your talents. More belief in your Christianity. More belief in your ministry. More belief in your attributes. And more belief when *'stepping out'* into something new whether at work, church or personally. Too many people today struggle with self-worth or find it difficult to believe in themselves and that applied to Moses in the bible too. When Moses was asked by God at the Burning Bush to go before Pharaoh and demand the release of his people [Exodus 3], He doubted himself and made excuses even though God was with Him. Yes, the great *'Man of God'*, Moses, had an inferiority complex, self-worth issues and even in Exodus 4, Moses was struggling with self-doubt, insecurity and self-confidence when he questioned God; *'What happens if'* things go wrong or I'm not up to it or I can't cope with the challenges you've given me [Exodus 4v1] and similar words to that effect on several other occasions in that chapter too. Sadly, there are many people who are like Moses, who feel either inadequate, inferior or insecure or all three. But in my experience and when we are honouring God with our lives, whenever we step out in faith or step into a new ministry at church or step into a new role at work, God always empowers you, enables you and equips you to do the work. So as the Olympics dominate our TV screens for the next month, be inspired by the athletes and sport stars to have more *'belief'* in yourself and *'Go for it'* and see what is possible. So, get ready to *'unleash the potential within you'* for God has given you a; *voice, talents, ability, personality, character, a smile, hope, salvation and His peace* and all that is a recipe for *'success'* whatever hurdles, challenges or difficulties come your way. Moreover, Philippians 4:13 says; *'I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me'*, maybe it's time you put it in to practice! Jesus' blessings. *Pastor Steve*
